You can be quite self-sufficient in managing your openathens account. You can reset your password, renew your account when prompted and move your account to another NHS organisation when you change employer. You will be notified by openathens, via email, when your account is due for renewal and it is important that you follow the instructions given to continue to access resources. Expired accounts are deleted via the system on a regular basis.
