


I wish you all the best for your time as a Keele student, and look forward to seeing the fantastic things that I am sure you can achieve.



Attendance monitoring

Attendance at taught sessions is a key factor in academic achievement, as well as ensuring you make the most of your time here and are able to connect with your peers. You are expected to attend all timetabled sessions.

You will need to use the Keele App to register your attendance at taught sessions, and will need to have Bluetooth enabled.

The Keele App is available to download onto smart devices, and is also available via a web browser – just go to www.app.keele.ac.uk.





Academic support

Your academic mentor is here to support you through your studies and will be a member of staff from your academic school. They should be your first point of contact if you have any concerns about your studies, and you should have regular meetings with them throughout the year.





Tracking your engagement

To further support our students and to identify more quickly those who may be in need of additional support, we use a student engagement dashboard called My Keele Journey.

The dashboard pulls together information from a range of sources including the KLE, the Library and Microsoft Teams to show a student's overall engagement with academic life, and allows you to compare your engagement with your wider cohort.

Your Students' Union plays a vital role in enriching your university experience by representing your interests, organising events, and providing support services to ensure you can make the most of your time at Keele.



Getting around

Keele students can access our local area easily by bus, with regular services operating between campus and local towns including Newcastleunder-Lyme. Stoke-on-Trent and Crewe. You can also access train services from Stoke-on-Trent or Crewe if you fancy a day out or weekend away.

You can buy a Keele Key ticket, which can get you a discounted rate on bus travel around the local area, by presenting your Keele Card (student ID card) when buying your ticket on the bus.



Train journeys from Stoke-on-Trent take from around:

40 MINUTES to Manchester 50 MINUTES to Birmingham

1HR 45 MINUTES to London



Entertainment

Newcastle-under-Lyme is also home to a Vue Cinema which plays all the latest blockbuster releases, as well as the New Vic Theatre, a theatre in the round where the audience encircles the stage for a fully immersive experience.

Stoke-on-Trent is home to the Regent Theatre and the Mitchell Arts Centre, as well as an Odeon Cinema close to the Festival Park retail park, which is home to a host of high street shops and restaurants.

We're also less than an hour away from the Trentham Gardens estate. The Peak District National Park, Chester Zoo. Alton Towers and the Trafford Centre!
