HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ABSTRACT

The committee welcomes abstracts of 300 words, outlining their proposed paper, along with a 100 word biography outlining course of study, experience and research interests. This should be submitted to the 'Under Construction' email inbox: underconstruction@keele.ac.uk.

The committee will then be in touch to advise on the outcome of the abstract, as to whether it has been accepted or rejected.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR PAPER

- Please submit your paper via email to <u>underconstruction@keele.ac.uk</u>.
- Please also include the following with your paper (i.e. in the word document):
 - \rightarrow A title.
 - \rightarrow A bibliography/filmography/discography.
 - → A full word count (main text + references in footnotes + any other footnotes).
 - \rightarrow Page numbers.
 - → Please do not include your contact details or name in the document containing the main article.
 - → If you wish to include any images, film clips or sound files with your paper, please send these as separate JPEG, MP3 or MP4 files (including clear captions) to our email address.

EDITING AND PUBLICATION

Once you submit your paper for publication, it will be reviewed by our editing team and peer reviewers. We will then provide you with feedback, and may ask you to make changes before publication.

The journal will be published online, on the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences website at Keele. If it is possible, the committee will commission a print-run. A number of hard copies will be published and disseminated throughout the university.

We will be in touch prior to publication as to whether you would be happy to have your email contact details and your biography made available online. This will enable readers of the journal to contact you about your paper or your research.

COPYRIGHT

Articles submitted for publication should be original contributions, and must not be currently under review with, nor already published in, any other journal or publication. If you wish to use any images, film clips or sound files, or wish to refer to unpublished documents, you need to ensure that you have copyright permission to do so.

Before publication, authors are requested to assign copyright to Keele University. The journal is an open access publication, licensed under a Creative Commons Attribution-
