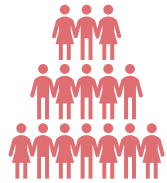

They can support students with things like:

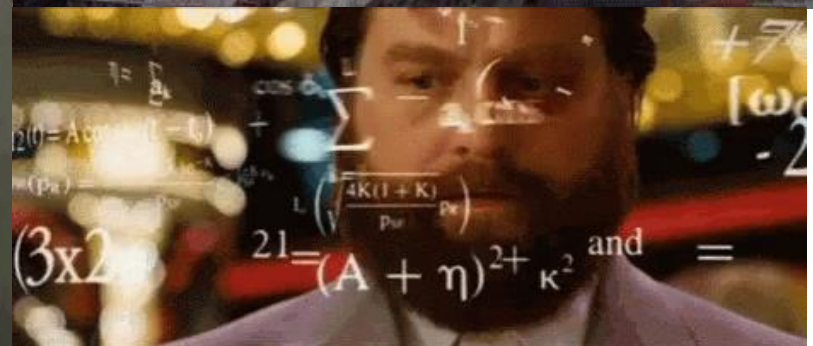

Skills for uni living

- There are some basic skills to prepare for when living on campus
 - Cooking
 - Laundry
 - Budgeting
 - Shopping



Cooking



- Bring the right equipment – e.g. non-stick pans, baking trays, colander, chopping board & knife and scales
- Try to pick up some skills before you arrive
- Club together with your flat for the basics – things like seasoning, bread, pasta etc. This will help to reduce waste too!
- If it all goes wrong and your meal doesn't go to plan, there's plenty of places to eat on campus and takeaways in the local area

Cleaning

- Accommodation blocks are cleaned on weekdays. There will be a notice board in your block with up-to-date cleaning details
- Kitchens and bathrooms are cleaned every week
- It is the residents' responsibility to keep the accommodation clean and tidy
- You will need to empty the rubbish during weekends and bank holidays when cleaning staff are not on duty



Laundry

- Each hall has its own launderette and the machines already have detergent & softener pre-loaded so you won't need to bring these!
- Top tips:
 - Check the labels!
 - Separate your colours
 - Treat any stains quickly
 - Get a laundry bag or basket
 - Check before putting things in the drier
